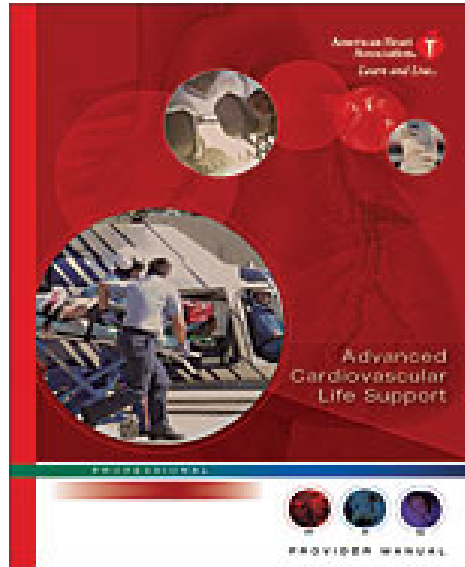

Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) Provider Course

It includes updated algorithms, and information on therapeutic agents, stroke, and acute coronary syndromes.

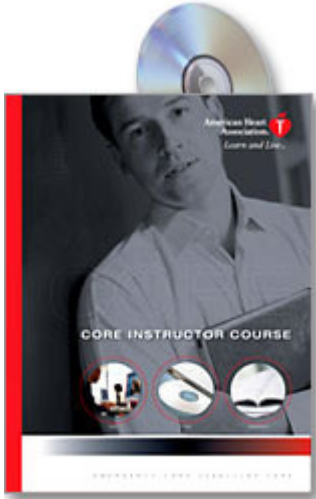
For use as a quick-reference for ECC healthcare provider instructors and students; personnel in emergency, intensive-care, or critical-care departments; and emergency medical care providers.

AHA Core Instructor Course (80-1050)

ACLS Instructor Manual (80-1086)

This revised manual includes detailed lesson maps (plans) to aid in conducting the ACLS courses (72 lesson maps for the ACLS course and 37 lesson maps for the ACLS renewal course). The courses are designed to be instructor-led using large group interaction, small group interaction, and small group skill-testing stations. Lesson maps allow instructors to see objectives of the lessons, instructor and student roles, and other key information. Includes an instructor CD with case-based scenarios and administrative precourse and course materials. 3-hole punched.
