- Computers are available for staff and patient family use
- Table of Contents (eTOC) service is available for current awareness

Internet Resources

Many of our internet resources are available from computers not connected to the St. Luke's network. Please contact the staff at your library to obtain passwords or schedule training.

UpToDate

Clinical decision support tool that includes graded treatment recommendations, drug database, patient information and CME tracking. (*Available inside the St. Luke's computer network only.*)

Natural Standard

Evidence-based Complementary & Alternative Medicine information including reviews on food, herbs, supplements, health & wellness interventions, medical conditions and interactions.

MDConsult

Medline access, full text of leading journals and Clinics, drug information, latest editions of eBooks in a wide range of specialties, and a collection of patient education materials.

EBSCOhost

Includes access to Medline, CINAHL, and the Cochrane suite of databases— plus health business, psychology, complementary health, patient education, newspaper, and many other resources.

eBooks

Access to a variety of eBooks is available through the library catalog. The available titles can be accessed through the following steps:

- Select the "Find a Book/Journal" tab on the library web site
- Click the link to "Catalog Home"
- Select "OPAC Search" in the menu bar on the left side of the screen
- Select "Reading Lists" from the sub-menu that appears, and then select the eBooks reading list for the available titles and links to full content
