Celebration 5K Run/Walk Saturday Road Closures

Event Facts:

- The St. Luke's Celebration Run, Walk, & Stroll takes place on Saturday, September 22nd.
- This is the Celebration's 15th year and it is the nation's largest women's road race – register today at www.celebrateall.org or at the Celebration Women's Show.
- The 3.1-mile course runs from the State Capitol, up Capitol Blvd, across Crescent Rim, down Americana Blvd and into Ann Morrison Park.
- Approximately 15,000 women & children of all ages and abilities will participate. The race includes elite runners, race walkers, and wheelchair athletes.
- The course is lined with entertainment showcases, volunteers, police, and cheering husbands, children, and boyfriends.
- The race benefits local women's and children's programs.

Road Closures:

- Boise downtown core from Jefferson to Front Street and 10th to 5th streets will be closed to traffic from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, September 22nd.
- Capitol Blvd. (Main street to Vista) and Crescent Rim (from Boise Depot to Latah) will be closed from 8:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Latah (Alpine to Americana) and Emerald from Roosevelt will be closed to all but local traffic, 7 a.m. to 11 a.m.
- Americana will be closed to all traffic on Saturday, September 22nd at 7:00 a.m. until noon.
