The Human Bean to Donate Proceeds to St. Luke's MSTI Breast Care Services

Boise, ID (October 22, 2007) – On Friday, October 26, 2007, coffee drinkers can get their morning pick-me-up and donate money to breast cancer detection at the same time. St. Luke's Mountain States Tumor Institute (MSTI) is pleased to announce that it will be the recipient of a donation from “The Human Bean” drive-thru coffee stores in Boise. Traditionally, the last Friday of every October, The Human Bean donates the entire day’s sales to benefit Breast Cancer services, and this year Boise area stores will begin participating in the yearly ritual.

All sales from 5:00 am to 9:00 pm will go toward providing services to women who are underinsured or uninsured at St. Luke's MSTI Breast Care Services. The Human Bean has three locations in Boise; at 12473 W. Chinden Blvd., 5602 W. State St., and 9162 W. Emerald.

St. Luke’s MSTI opened its doors in 1969 and is now Idaho’s largest provider of cancer services, caring for approximately 800 patients each day. St. Luke’s operates five MSTI facilities throughout Idaho, six Breast Cancer Detection Centers, two diagnostic breast-imaging sites, and a mobile mammography unit. Since that time, the experts at St. Luke’s MSTI have cared for more than 59,000 adult and pediatric patients.
