*Mammogram scholarships enhance community health  
More than Seventy Women to Benefit*

**KETCHUM, ID (May 16, 2008)** —The St. Luke's Wood River Medical Center recently announced that approximately 75 women benefited from the mammogram scholarship fund at St. Luke's Wood River Medical Center in 2007. Just over \$5,200 was provided for these scholarships through the generosity of the St. Luke's Wood River Volunteer Core and the St. Luke's Wood River Foundation, in collaboration with the My Blue Dots not-for-profit organization.

In 2008, the mammogram scholarships will be funded by generous grants of \$5,000 from the St. Luke's Volunteer Core and an additional \$5,000 from the Foundation with My Blue Dots. Founded by part-time Sun Valley resident Sue McCollum, My Blue Dots supports breast cancer research and cancer care programs through sales of hand blown blue glass ornaments, which can be purchased at the St. Luke's Volunteer Core gift shop in the hospital.

Working together, these organizations have assured the continued success of the mammogram scholarship fund, which was created to assist women who could not otherwise afford this essential annual diagnostic screening. Mammograms are recommended for all women over 40 years of age.
