

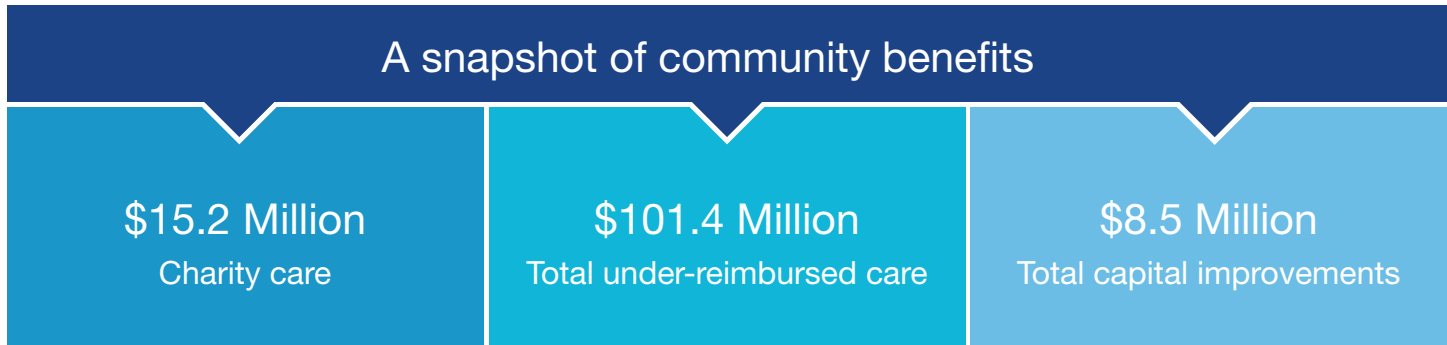

## St. Luke's by the Numbers 2024 Magic Valley Overview

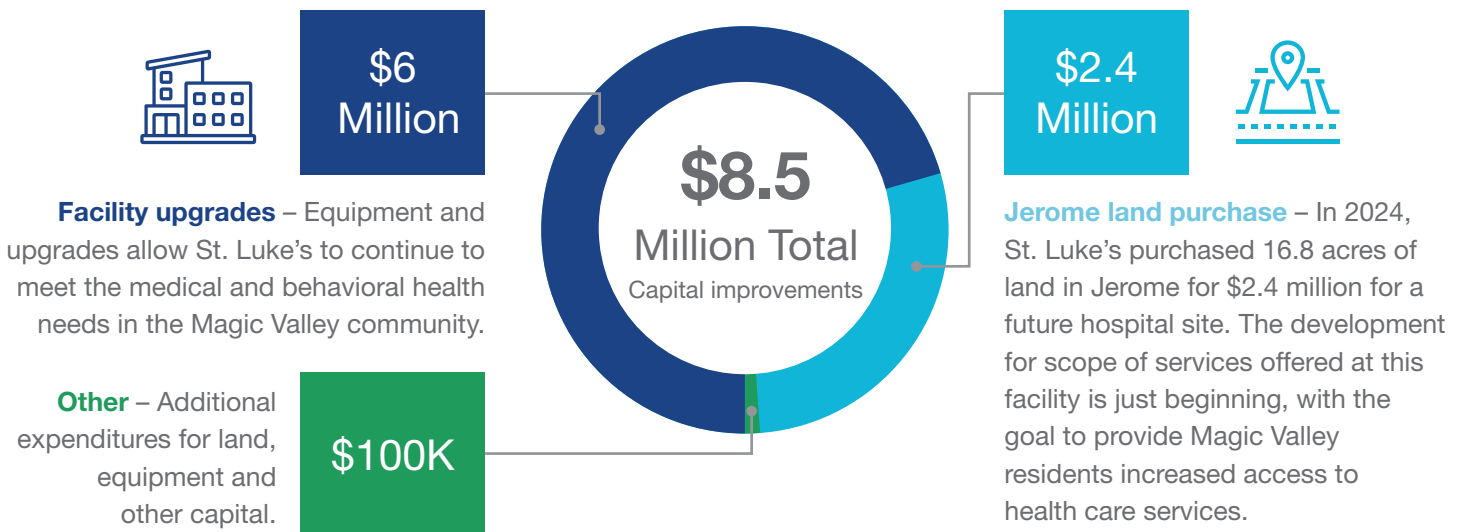
What began as Twin Falls County Hospital in 1918 has evolved into the state-of-the-art St. Luke's Magic Valley Medical Center and a vital part of the communities it serves, providing a full range of inpatient and outpatient services to the people of Twin Falls and Jerome, as well as southern Idaho and northern Nevada.

### What do capital improvements include?

One hundred percent of St. Luke's net revenue is reinvested into land, facilities, equipment and other capital supporting the hospital system's mission.
